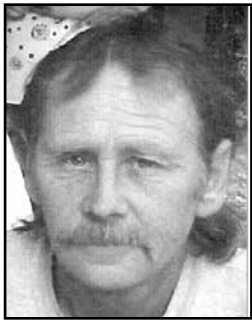


# Obituaries

The charity quilt will be auctioned during a silent auction at the Wayne County EH Quilt Show held Friday and Saturday, May 19 and 20, at the Raper Center on the Wayne County Fairgrounds, Richmond, IN. Tickets are \$5 at the door and the public is invited.

Until March 10: The quilt is currently on display at Pohlar Fabrics at its new location at 941 West Coe Street south of Liberty, Indiana, on Route 101 near the entrance to Brookville Lake. The store is a dealer of Bernina sewing and quilting machines and sells quilt fabrics, patterns, and other quilting-related items. The charity quilt can be seen during the store's regular hours from 9:30 am to 5 pm, Monday through Saturday.

March 16 - 25: The Stitching Nook will host the charity quilt during its regular hours from 10 am to 5 pm Monday through Saturday. Located at 4629 National Road West in Richmond, the Stitching Nook offers a wide variety of quilting products and Husqvana Viking Sewing machines plus classes for the beginning through the more experienced quilter.

April 24 - April 29: The third quilt shop to display the charity quilt is in Stitches Quilt Shop located at 837 W 3d Street, Rushville, IN. The hours are 10 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday and 10 am to 2 pm Saturday. According to its website, the Shop's niche is quilt panels along with 1000 bolts of brand name quilt fabrics.

If you have a quilt to exhibit, please contact us to preregister to be recognized in our program book. There is no charge to exhibit quilts, and you can show as many quilts as you want.
