## Tiger Track Competes at Anderson, School Records Fall

Hagerstown's track squads competed Saturday, March 11, at the Patriot Indoor Track Meet at Anderson University and posted several excellent results. Aimee Hoodlebrink won the long jump with a leap of 16-0.75 and was sixth in a school-record time of 8.45 in the 60 meters to post the top placings for the Lady Tigers. For the boys, Mason Bledsoe placed second in the 3200 in 9:59.85, an indoor school record. Owen Gollither placed sixth in the 60 meters in a school-record time of 7.31. The boys DMR team of Kaleb Slagle, Holden Robinson, Logan Tuttle, and Mason Bledsoe was third overall, setting the fourth school record of the evening with a clocking of 11:28.02.

Other placings for HHS included Keeton Adams fifth in shot, and the boys 4 x 800 relay of Logan Tuttle, Alec Hicks, Jevon Osborne, and Kaleb Slagle, sixth.
