 BROOKVILLE, IN — The Franklin County High School baseball team is excited to announce "Night with a Legend" featuring Marty Brenneman, the radio voice of the Cincinnati Reds! This event will be held on Saturday, December 10 at Third Place Event Center, 734 Main St, Brookville, IN. This evening will feature a social hour beginning at 6:00, dinner at 7:00 and Marty Brenneman will entertain the crowd beginning at 8:00.

This is a 21 and over event, and alcohol will be served. Ticket sales are on a first come, first served basis. General Admission tickets are \$75 each, and they include the social hour, appetizers, dinner and Mr. Brenneman's presentation. V.I.P. tickets will be available as well for \$125 each. These tickets include a private meet-and-greet opportunity with Mr. Brenneman, the social hour, special appetizers, dinner and Mr. Brenneman's presentation.

All income raised from this event will help with uniform, equipment and facility upgrades. Perhaps most importantly, the goal is to help reduce or eliminate the individual cost to the players as well. Franklin County High School baseball is honored that Mr. Brenneman has agreed to support the team, coaching staff and coach Dave Miley as he enters his first year as the Wildcats head coach.

"Marty has been a great supporter and friend throughout the years," said coach Miley. "He practically jumped at the chance to help us out, and I couldn't be more grateful."

Coach Miley enjoyed a long, successful professional career in the Cincinnati Reds and New York Yankees organizations. Miley spent over 25 years with the Cincinnati Reds' organization as a player, coach and manager. He led the Louisville Bats to a Governor's Cup Championship in 2001, and managed the Cincinnati Reds for parts of three seasons from 2003 - 2005. As a member of the Yankees' organization, Miley was named International League Manager of the Year twice, in 2007 and 2012, and led the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees to their first Governor's Cup in 2008. Coach Miley believes that his experience at the professional level will translate well to the high school level, and he is eager to begin.

"I've been fortunate to be around and coach a lot of good players," he said. "With our combined experience as a coaching staff, each player will get better and we'll be prepared and fundamentally sound this season."

Marty Brenneman is an accomplished broadcaster whose experience includes collegiate and professional basketball and football, but he is best known as being the radio voice of Major League Baseball's Cincinnati Reds since 1974. Although his style of broadcasting is opinionated and sometimes controversial, Mr. Brenneman is well respected around MLB, and is loved by fans and players alike.

Mr. Brenneman's style of broadcasting sets him apart from many of his colleagues, and has led to numerous career awards. He has been named Ohio Sportscaster of the Year twelve times, Virginia Sportscaster of the Year four times and inducted into the National Sportscasters and Sportswriters Association and the National Radio Halls of Fame. His highest award came in 2000 when he won the Ford C. Frick Award for broadcasting, presented annually by the National Baseball Hall of Fame for "major contributions to the game of baseball".

In addition to his many awards, Mr. Brenneman's baseball career highlights include calling Pete Rose's career hit 4192, Hank Aaron's career homerun 714, five no-hitters, one perfect game and three World Series championships. However, his most cherished highlight is broadcasting Cincinnati Reds baseball alongside the "ole lefthander" Joe Nuxhall for a record 31 years.

Because of his popularity, "Night with a Legend", featuring Marty Brenneman, promises to be an entertaining evening, and a great showcase of FCHS baseball for the entire tri-state. Mr. Brenneman's presentation will include a mix of stories and anecdotes from his illustrious career. He will also offer a "state of the Reds", and will open the floor up to for questions and answers afterwards.
