## Indiana State Chamber Reports Wayne County Statistics

Small rural communities sometimes perceive that leaders and organizations in Indianapolis forget about us. However, Monday, August 7th, the Indiana State Chamber traveled to IU East to report findings from the the WGU sponsored Indiana Vision 2025 Report card. Vision 2025 provides state averages in key areas and this meeting highlighted how our region compares to the rest of the State.

The "region" defined as East Central Indiana (ECI), for purposes of Vision 2025, includes: Wayne, Randolph, Henry, Shelby, Rush, Fayette and Union counties. The 4 pillars measured are:

- 1) Talent, which includes workforce and education levels;
- 2) Business Climate, which includes the health of our residents and ease of doing business for companies here;
- 3) Infrastructure, including transportation, roads and utilities; and
- 4) Dynamic and Creative Culture, which includes quality of life, job availability, and personal and professional growth opportunities which both draw and retain people desiring to live and work here.

The ECI region can be proud that the current high school graduation rate is more than 4% higher than the State; however, we have much work to do in other areas. ECI residents aged 25 to 64, lag the state average in holding a high school diploma. Additionally, we are far below the state average in those earning an associates, bachelors degree or higher, or STEM related degree.

Poverty is often associated with lower education rates, which might explain why this region reports 15.2% of residents live in poverty compared to 11.8% statewide. And, our Per Capita Income is reported at \$21,714 compared to Indiana's \$26,396. Councilwoman Maryanne Butters requested a further breakdown of the per capita income in order to further analyze this issue.

Our region is doing slightly better in curbing smoking rates at 18.7%, compared to 20.6% for the state; however, East Central Indiana exceeds the State in obesity rates at 33% compared to 31.3% for Indiana as a whole.

Finally, the rate of migration indicates this region has work to do in order to keep talented individuals living and working here.

Follow up discussion yielded a multitude of good ideas and strong interest in working to improve regional numbers. The meeting concluded with a panel of community leaders answering questions and commenting on the pillars discussed by Chamber Members.
